Twin City Jr Thunder Financial Obligations:

- (a) The parents/guardians agree to pay Hodge Hockey LLC (herein, HH LLC.) the non-refundable tuition posted. (b) Any and all legal costs involved in collecting the aforementioned full tuitions will be paid by the parents/guardians. (c) We, the parents/guardians, fully understand our financial obligations to Hodge Hockey LLC (d) The parents/guardians agree to pay the full amount of the said tuition regardless of whether the player should voluntarily leave the team or be released by association for any reasons allowed in the covenants of this agreement. There will be no pro-rated or refunded monies due to injury or of absences. (e) Failure to pay your tuition in full by **JULY 15TH 2024**, will result in your player not being allowed at team practices, games, or off ice activities until tuitions are completed. (f) A 3 % processing fee will be added to all tuition credit card payments. (g) Hodge Hockey LLC has the right/ability to apply late fee to all accounts with past due balances

Any or all ice times, clinic, skills, games, etc. are subject to change without warning due to circumstances beyond the control of any or all associations involved, and no association will be held liable for any damages incurred.

Hodge Hockey LLC/Twin City Jr Thunder Release of Liability/Acknowledgment of Risk:

In consideration of being allowed to participate as a student, player, instructor, coach, counselor, assistant, parent or volunteer (herein called "participant") in any team activities and others, including the Hodge Hockey LLC. Twin City Jr. Thunder Organization, the undersigned acknowledge and agrees that: (a) The "participant" in or observation of ice skating, ice hockey and dry land training sports activities have inherent physical risk that may result in serious injury including permanent paralysis or death. (b) I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, and assume full responsibility for my child's participation. (c) I understand and agree that neither Hodge Hockey LLC. nor any of its officers, directors, shareholders, employees, agents, coaches, referees, ice rink or employees of the rink used by HH LLC. organization shall be held liable for any accidents, injury (including paralysis and or death), loss of equipment of any other costs, expenses, damages or losses in connection with such participation. (d) The "participant" is responsible for any and all medical costs for injuries arising from or around the program activities. (e) I hereby represent to the program that my son or daughter has no known medical/physical/psychological condition that restricts or prohibits participation in ice hockey, ice skating or any related activity. Nor does participant have any known medical/psychological condition which puts him or her at greater risk or injury or death resulting from any risks associated with participation in program activities, whether such risks are known or unknown to the parent or participant. (f) In the event of an injury or illness, I give permission for the program or its designee to provide, or make arrangements for the provisions or emergency first aid. (g) The program reserves the right to terminate participation in the program activities based upon inappropriate behavior by the participant or the parents/guardians without refund. Participants shall act in a mature and responsible manner. Any behavior that the program deems to endanger the safety of other persons or property, or jeopardizes the program's ability to conduct business, will result in the participant's immediate expulsion. Participant may also be expelled from participation in the program activities for financial delinquencies, failure to abide by all the program and ice rink rules and directives and or falsify any of the participant's registration information.

It is expected that all Twin City Jr. Thunder parents observe the following principles:

- Children are involved in organized sports for *their* enjoyment. I will encourage and support my child's desire to play his/her chosen sport but will not pressure him/her into participating.
- I will remember that the game is fun. I will not taunt or disturb other fans, or embarrass my child by yelling at players, coaches, or officials.
- I will support and promote Fair Play by encouraging my child to play by the rules. I will display good sportsmanship by applauding a good effort by both teams in victory and defeat, and respecting players, coaches, and officials.
- I will remember that "wins" are based on my child's performance, teamwork, and playing within the rules.
- I will recognize the importance of volunteer coaches and will take the time to attend team meetings to get to know my child's coach's philosophy, expectations, and guidelines. I will communicate with my child's coaches and support them.
- I understand that when my child is on the ice, the coaches do the coaching. I will not yell instructions to my child from the sidelines or give my child instructions counter to those of the coach.
- I understand that it is my role to teach my child sportsmanship, how to deal with success and failure, and to support my child's development in the game.
- I will strive to become knowledgeable about the rules of the game and support the official's decisions on and off the ice.
- I understand the importance of skill development. For the lower age groups, I will remember that practices benefit my child more than games and competition.
- I will respect locker rooms as private areas for players, coaches, and officials.
- I will not place unreasonable expectations on my child.

I have read and understood the principles stated above that were put forth by the Twin City Jr. Thunder. I agree to abide by those principles with the understanding that if I do not follow them I may be asked to leave any practice, game, or event.
